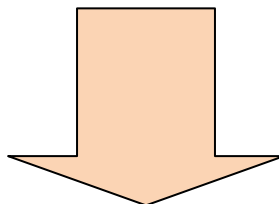
The weekend will be organized as follows:

The Common meeting for families on Saturday afternoon (13:00) is compulsory for all families. Please do not be late since the first part is particularly for the children.
